The process

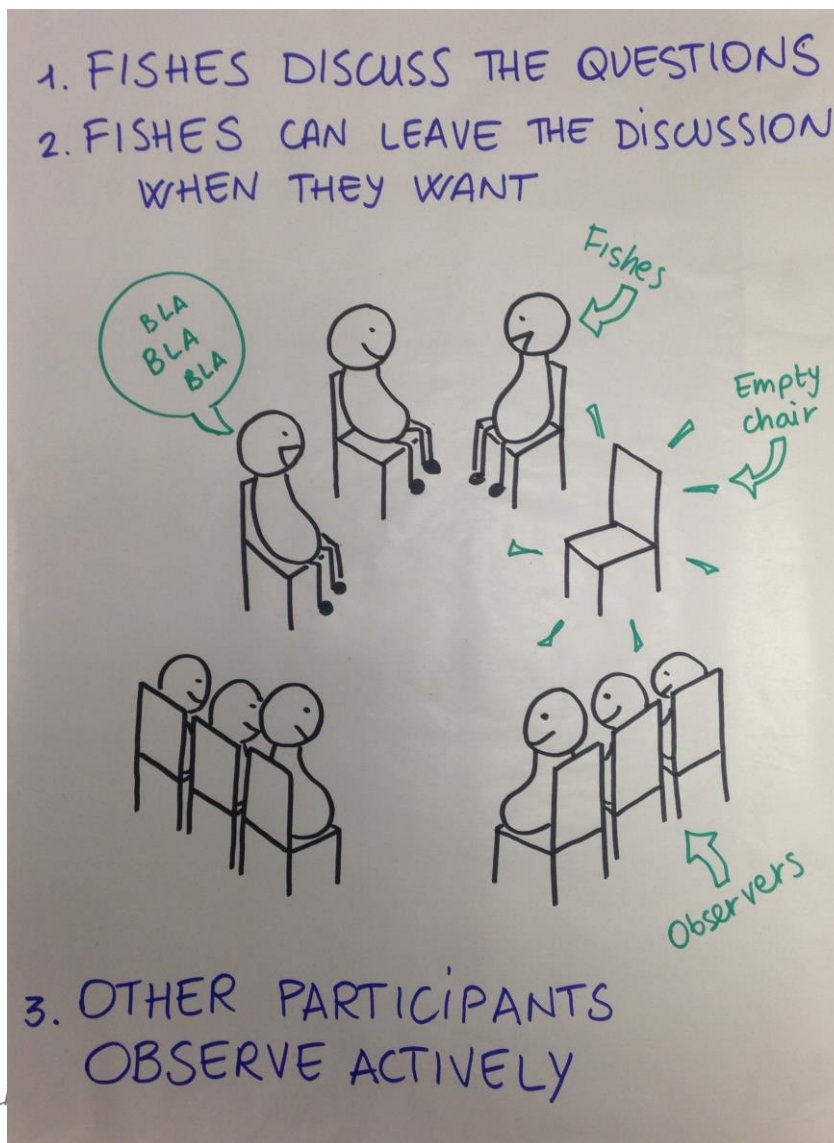
- We are breaking into smaller groups for the workshops (until 10.45am)
