Obj. 1 | Foster a Resilient Farm Sector

Specific Objectives:



- To support viable farm income and resilience across the Union to enhance food security
- Enhance market orientation and increase competitiveness, including greater focus on research, technology and digitalisation
- Improve farmers' position in the value chain

Proposed activities: All TBC



- 1 or 2 Thematic Groups on Transforming Food Supply Chains, two meetings per year – linked to analytical screening – starting Winter 2021
- Workshop on 'The Farm-to-Fork Strategy and cooperation in the agri-food supply chain', **2 December 2021**
- 1-2 further capacity building workshops for MAs and PAs (food chain and CAP/RD)
- Large event: 150 people on 'Building synergies between CAP and Rural Development interventions' in Spring/Summer 2022
- Good practices on GO 1 (circa 60)
- Analytic screening, linked to 'Food supply chains' and cooperation
- 4/5 website articles, contribution to Projects Brochure

Obj. 2 | Bolster Environment and Climate



Specific Objectives:

- Contribute to climate change mitigation and adaptation, as well as sustainable energy
- Foster sustainable development and efficient management of natural resources such as water, soil and air
- Contribute to the protection of biodiversity, enhance ecosystem services and preserve habitats and landscapes



Proposed activities: All TBC

- 1 Thematic Group – topic tbc (e.g. CAP Green Architecture, carbon farming, forestry, quality schemes etc.) - starting early 2022
- Up to 2 further MA / PA workshops
- Good practices on GO2 (circa 60)
- Analytic screening – linked to future TGs and topics e.g. – forestry measures/ interventions, Eco-schemes, nature based solutions
- 4/5 website articles, contribution to a Project Brochure

Obj. 3 | Strengthen Fabric in Rural Areas



Specific Objectives:

- Attract young farmers and facilitate business development in rural areas
- Promote employment, growth, social inclusion and local development in rural areas, including bio-economy and sustainable forestry
- Improve the response of EU agriculture to societal demands on food and health, including safe, nutritious and sustainable food, food waste, and animal welfare



Proposed activities: All TBC

- 2 Thematic Groups each of 2 meetings linked to the LTVRA, covering Rural Revitalisation, **15 December 2021** and Rural Proofing, **27 January 2022** – linking theory and practice
- 1 Thematic Group on LEADER; A series of coordinated supporting tools and events
- Large event: 150 people on steps taken towards the ideas in the Long Term Vision
- 1 capacity building workshop, MA and PAs – topic TBC – Summer 2022
- Good Practices (Circa 60) and analysis
- Regular news items and website articles
