National level

- Coordination and harmonisation of CLLD implementation (common LDS selection)
- Better targeting of LDS in line with RDP objectives (common indicators)
- More beneficiary –friendly delivery system (umbrella projects)
- Simplification of procedures (SCOs)
- Boosting cooperation (NRN technical assistance)
- Better communication and information exchange with LAGs (subgroups)
- LDS database (more detailed and easy to access information)



Regional level

- Shortening the average time of applications checks (cuts in TA transfers)
- Changes in applications processing at regional level (tasks division between LAGs and regional offices)
- Greater emphasis on LAG performance and LDS results assessment
- Changes in appeal procedure (regional office as second instance institution)



LAG level

- Focus on job creation not infrastructure
- Better recognisability of LAGs
- Advisory role of LAG
- Reaching LDS milestones
- Implementation of communication plans
- Changes in financing M&A costs (focus on results not financial documents)
- LAG network and good pratices exchange
