

Why do we want to evaluate NRN?

For NRN stakeholders

Assess the effectiveness, efficiency, results and impacts of NRN activities

Improve the NRN design and the quality of its implementation

Enhance the NRN governance and steering

For outside world

Demonstrate what has been achieved with NRN activities

Increase transparency and accountability of NRN interventions

Justify and legitimise the use of public funds



Why do we **have** to evaluate NRNs?

→ Any intervention supported by ESI-funds are subject of evaluation!

Improve the quality of design and implementation of programmes and assess their effectiveness, efficiency and impact (1303/2013, Art. 54)

Common monitoring and evaluation system and its objectives (1305/2013, Art. 67-68)

Minimum requirements of the evaluation plan (1305/2013, Art. 7)

NRN

NRN - part of rural development policy (1305/2013, Art. 54)

NRN in the RDP evaluation plan (808/2014, Annex I, Part 1.9)

Common output indicators (808/2014, Annex IV)





 (Structuring, Observing, Analysing, Judging)
