## European Rural Networks' Assembly 2nd Meeting

#### Context and objectives of the meeting

The Rural Networks' Assembly is the main governance body of the ENRD and EIP-AGRI networks. A strategic framework for the networks has been put in place, and 2015 has effectively been the first year of the networks' activities in the 2014-2020 programming period. Over this period most of the RDPs have been approved.

#### The objectives of the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Assembly are to:

- Consider the main messages emerging from the preliminary review of the RDPs.
- Take stock of the activities of the networks up to now in the context of the strategic framework.
- Discuss and make proposals for the 2016 priority activities of the European Rural Networks in light of the opportunities identified for improving RDP implementation.
- Debate and make proposals for ensuring the Rural Networks' governance structures are effective in responding to the needs of the different stakeholders and to encourage active involvement of the RN Assembly members in future activities.
