 - in relation to EIP Operational Groups
- Good practices appear to be a tool relevant across all surveyed stakeholder groups
- Good practices are particularly wished in the following fields
 - Innovation; added value; knowledge transfer and exchange (EU)
 - Ways of controlling costs of investments (EU)
 - Support to Operational Groups (EU)
 - Implementation of Measure 16 (national/regional)
 - Public procurement (national/regional)
 - Application of Simplified Cost Options (national/regional)
