#### What to avoid – barriers - blockages

- Supply led rather than led by business needs
- Overlaps and gaps in provision
- Rigid demarcation, heavy eligibility rules obstacles to building linkages
- Difficulties in combining and coordinating calls and measures
- Fixed grant led schemes not related to market needs
- Difficulty in dealing with small scale projects, risky and uncertain projects .....
- Long delays heavy administrative costs.....

- Synergy between measures,
   e.g. Knowledge transfer +
   Investment Measures
- Designing and implementing measures in ways that meet business needs.
