Our motivation for working with this topic

The LAG area, located between the Austrian capital Vienna and the Slovak capital Bratislava, experiences numerous peri-urban phenomena such as fast population growth requiring various types of social integration, competing forms of land use and basic service provision.

This is what we did and do

The LAG supports projects contributing to sustainable community development, including:

- The 'LENA' project works to achieve a common understanding of viable design and development of buildings among the 28 municipalities in the region.
- The 'G28' project provides educational programmes, networking and exchange of know-how among local communities to further the region's development.
- A project focused on rural youth compiles a portfolio of offers for young people such as mobile youth work, a youth counselling centre and open youth work.
- The 'Vielfalt Leben' project ("Living diversity") works to improve the social coexistence of the region's old and new inhabitants, including asylum seekers.
