




How many trainings were organized?



How many participants attended Helpdesk trainings so far?




Distribution of participants by category and by MS

Overall assessment by training participants




The **feedback form**:

Conclusions

- Capacity building attracted so far mostly Managing
 Authorities and ministries concerned with building up the
 monitoring and evaluation system in the Member States.
- Representatives of Local Action Groups and NRNs are increasingly interested in evaluation-related trainings due to new evaluation requirements.
- Awareness for evaluation-related capacity building has considerably increased in the Member States (e.g. many follow-up actions).
