

# The role of the Steering Group members

-> **Source of information** for EU RN assessment: e.g. *How RN outcomes are disseminated/used?* 

One of the key tasks of SG and Assembly is to assess EU RN

-> "Drivers" of the assessment process









### Examples of assessment questions:

- Were the examples developed and shared by the ENRD useful and practiced/used at national & regional levels?
- To what extent the EIP-AGRI network contributed to translating research results into farming practices?
- To what extent have the evaluation capacities been improved?

## Methods/sources: stakeholder feedback, surveys – e.g. upcoming communication survey of the ENRD


