# <u>Kick-off of the 3rd Thematic Working Group on the Evaluation of LEADER/CLLD</u> - Brussels, Belgium

The primary objective of the 3rd Thematic Working Group is to produce Guidelines, which will serve to assist Managing Authorities and evaluators better understand and fulfill the requirements related to the evaluation of LEADER/CLLD. The kick off meeting included the Evaluation Helpdesk, drafting experts, peer reviewers and representatives of DG AGRI Unit E.4.

**Main output**: Timeline and outline document of the activities for the drafting of the Guidelines.
