Main objectives of the workshop:


- To identify innovative practices to promote social inclusion in rural areas, with specific focus on the contribution of RDPs



Nicosia, known locally as Lefkosia, is the capital and largest city of Cyprus since the 10th century and is located at the center of the Island. Lefkosia is an important cultural and political centre. It has been continuously inhabited for over 4500 years. "With its distinction as the only divided capital in the world, Lefkosia (Nicosia) and its surrounding region combines the heartbeat of the island's commercial and businesses centre with an interesting past, and rural areas where escape is possible in naturally beautiful, green environs. The capital itself is steeped in history and culture, with a charming old city surrounded by massive Venetian walls, and the island's largest concentration of museums, art galleries and religious and historical monuments, that all tell wonderful stories of the island through the ages" (Cyprus Tourism Organisation).
