DESIRA - Modelling broadband access impact on the economic growth at NUTS 3 level

Potential use in evaluation of the CAP

- A quantitative model for assessing the impact of broadband access to regional economic growth.
- Useful for assessing the effects of interventions that aim to increase the digitalisation of rural areas, in particular, the effects on economic growth.
- Works with data at NUTS3 level that was previously missing for analysing broadband access.



DESIRA – <u>Methodology for</u> <u>impact evaluation of</u> <u>digitalisation</u>

- A qualitative method based on the creation of Living Labs.
- Useful to assess the impacts of digitalisation on process like supply chain management.
- Method may be used to assess (qualitatively) the links between digitalisation and the Sustainable Development Goals.


Potential use in evaluation of the CAP

- Useful for understanding the effects of measures related to the digitalisation of agriculture, forestry and rural areas.




