

What does the Communication say?

√ Why?

- ✓ Multidimensional nature of rural development
- ✓ Treaty: economic, social and **territorial cohesion**
- ✓ =>« Need to consider impacts and implications on rural jobs and growth +
 development prospects, social well-being and equal opportunities for all, and the
 environmental quality of rural areas ».

√ What?

- ✓ Rural proofing mechanism under **better regulation agenda**...
- √ ... to assess the anticipated impact of major EU legislative initiatives on rural areas
- ✓ Ensure coherence, consistency and complementarity between policies
- ✓ Using **territorial impact assessments** and...
- ✓ ... better monitoring of the situation of rural areas.

Coordination, responsibilities and follow-up

- ✓ Communication (non-legislative) from the European Commission => Commission is responsible and committed
- ✓ Inter-service steering group including all relevant EC departments ("DGs") coordinated by the Secretariat general
- ✓ EC Departments **Agriculture and rural development** (AGRI) and **Regional and urban policy** (REGIO) support colleagues + check delivery (inter-service groups and consultations)
- ✓ Stock-taking in 2023


