- ✓ A new **Thematic Group on Bioeconomy** (July 2018 – June 2019) >> under the ENRD overarching priority of *Greening the rural economy* in response to **growing stakeholders' interest** in the topic
- ✓ **Regained momentum** → Revision of the *EU Bioeconomy Strategy* (2017) and *Future CAP proposals*
- ✓ **~170 members representing 25 EU Member States + 3 third countries (FYROM, MD, NO)** (including RDPs' Managing Authorities and Paying Agencies, European organisations, farmers' associations, researchers and private sector representatives)

TG objectives, focus and main expected outcomes

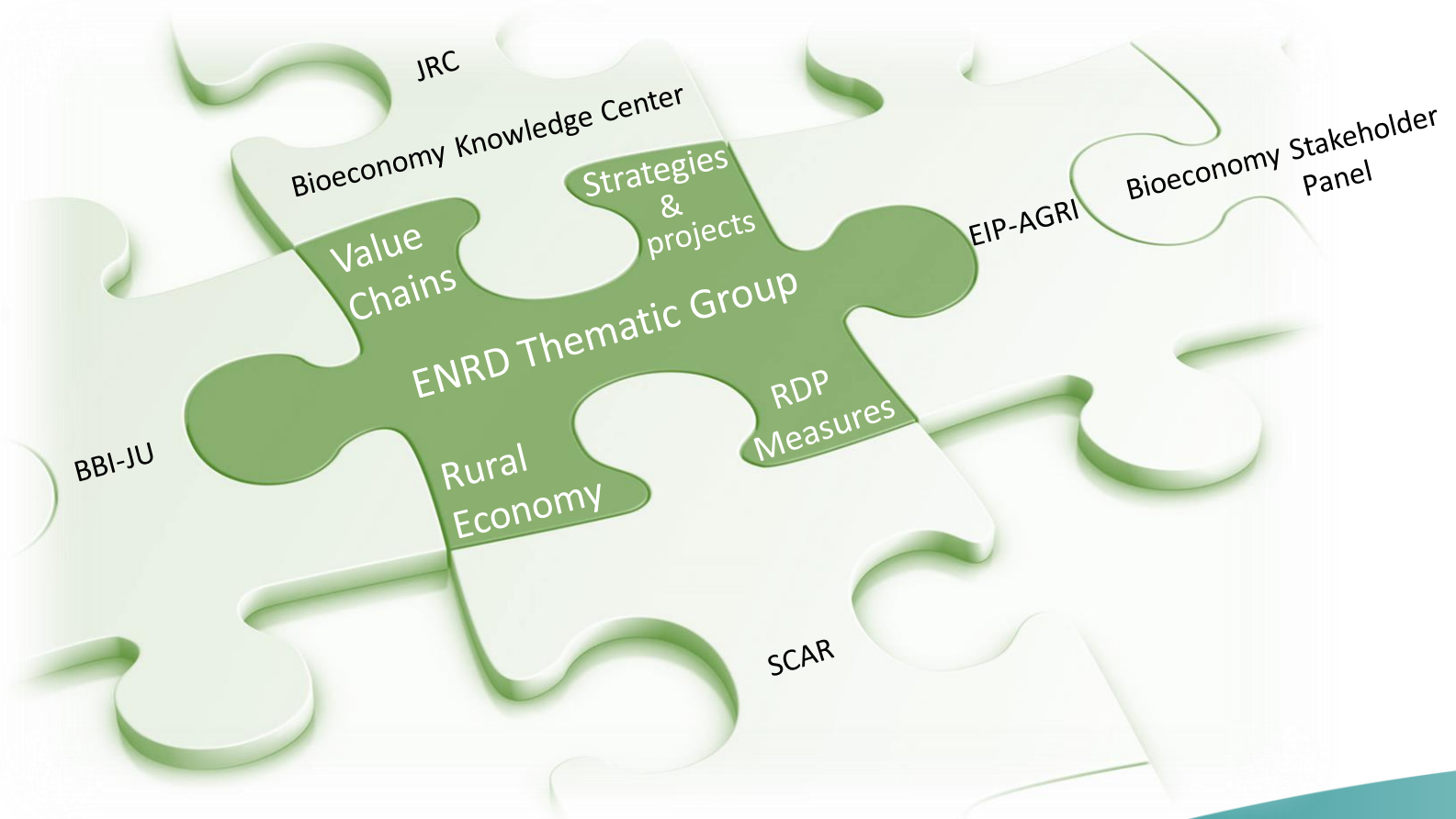
✓ To encourage the development of sustainable bioeconomy **value chains** in rural areas in order to promote employment and economic growth, while preserving eco-systems
