# | “Green Deal” or “no deal”? The fear of failure

- **Green Deal Communication** (December 2019):
  - Various targets, ambitions
  - Commission to work with MS to ensure that CAP Strategic Plans reflect these ambitions
- **Working Document – links between CAP reform & Green Deal** (May 2020):
  - What needs to be included in the final post-2020 CAP (“PLEASE let it be green”... 😞!)
  - “Structured dialogue” with MS – including **recommendations**
- **Farm to Fork Communication** (May 2020):
  - Commission will make “**recommendations**” to Member States on 9 CAP specific objectives
  - Will ask MS to set “national values” in relation to key Green Deal targets



## | Recommendations to Member States...

- ...will be made before draft CAP plans are officially submitted
- ...will be intended to influence CAP plan design through persuasion
- ...will **not** replace the “bottom-up” approach to designing CAP plans
- ....will **not** impose pre-determined national target values on MS
- ...will **not** be the only links between CAP plans and the Green Deal
  - MS' SWOT analyses will naturally take into account Green Deal concerns
  - CAP reform proposal: formal link between CAP plans and various items of legislation

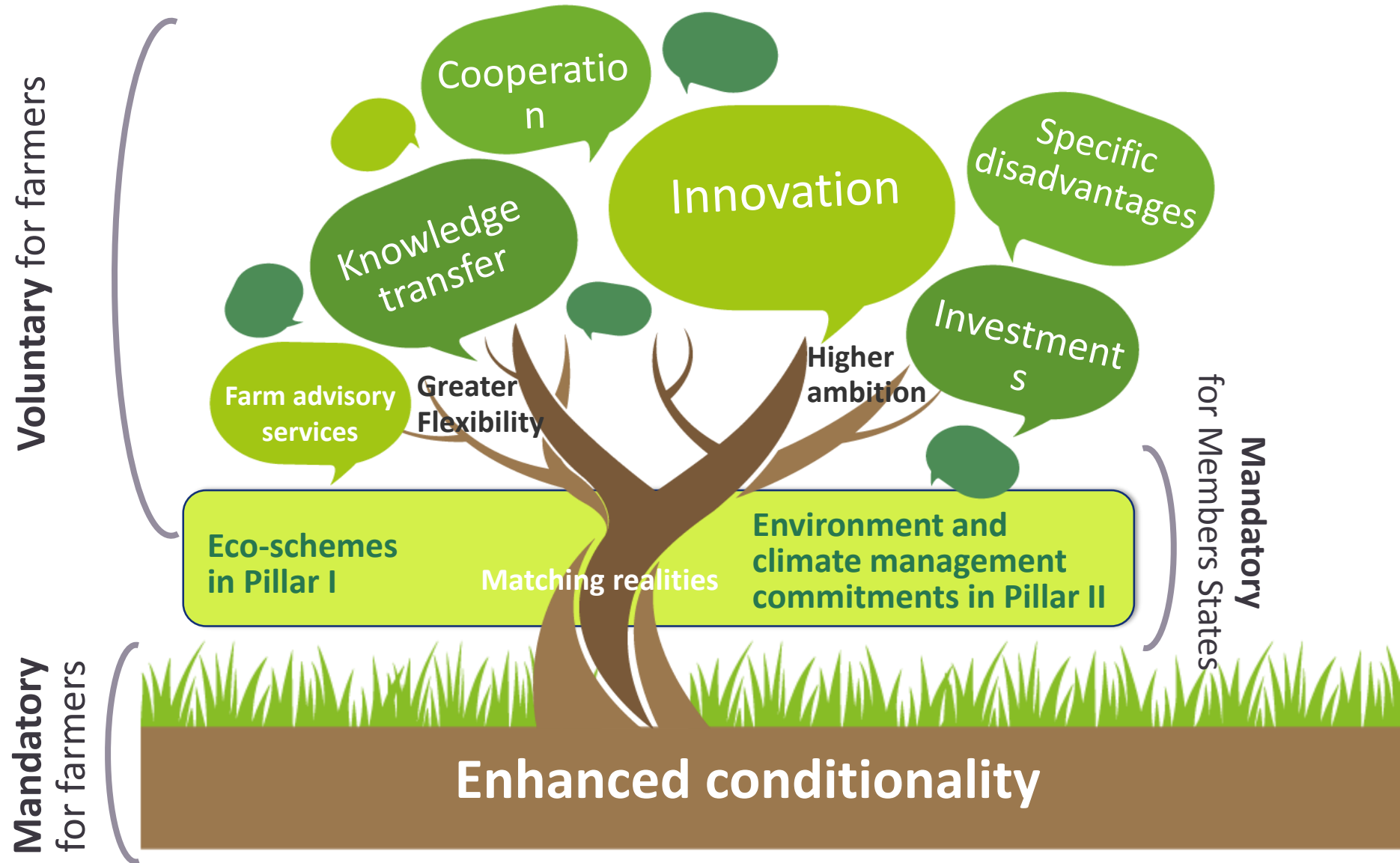
