

Eating and drinking on Bornholm

Annual consumption/turnover: 140 Mio. Euro 80% locals - 20% tourists self-sufficiency rate: very low

estimated 5%! - 7 Mio Euro/Year









Assumption: An annual turnover of 150.000 Euro is equivalent to 1 job

Means if we can higher the selfsufficiency rate to 10%

It will be equivalent to 46 jobs







Land use: Agriculture 34.000 Ha (60% of total Island area)

Pig production on Bornholm 500.000 slaughter pigs/year

Animals need protein

Import of Soya from South America Costs: 15 Mio Euro/Year







It's seams that 50% of all protein for the pigs can be replaces by local grown fava beans - without extra cost's!

Added local value: 7,5 Mio Euro/Year
