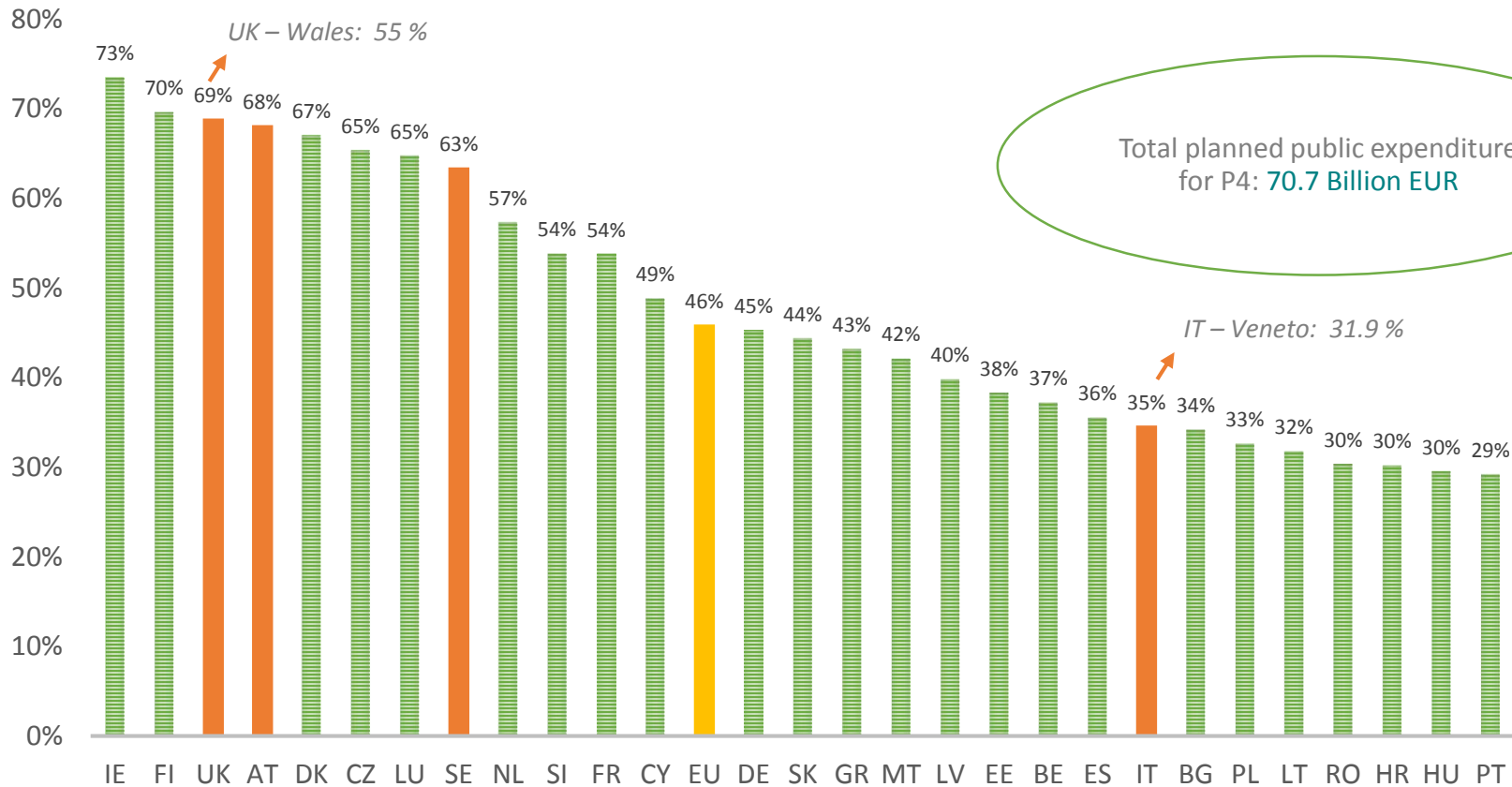

EU-28 overview

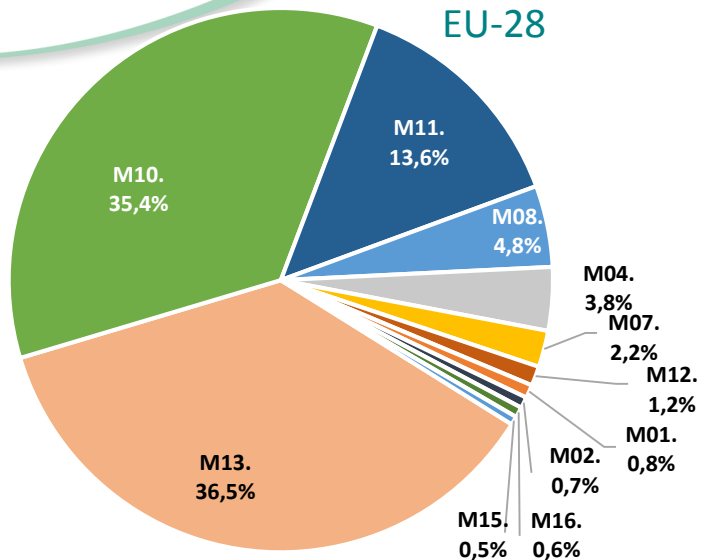

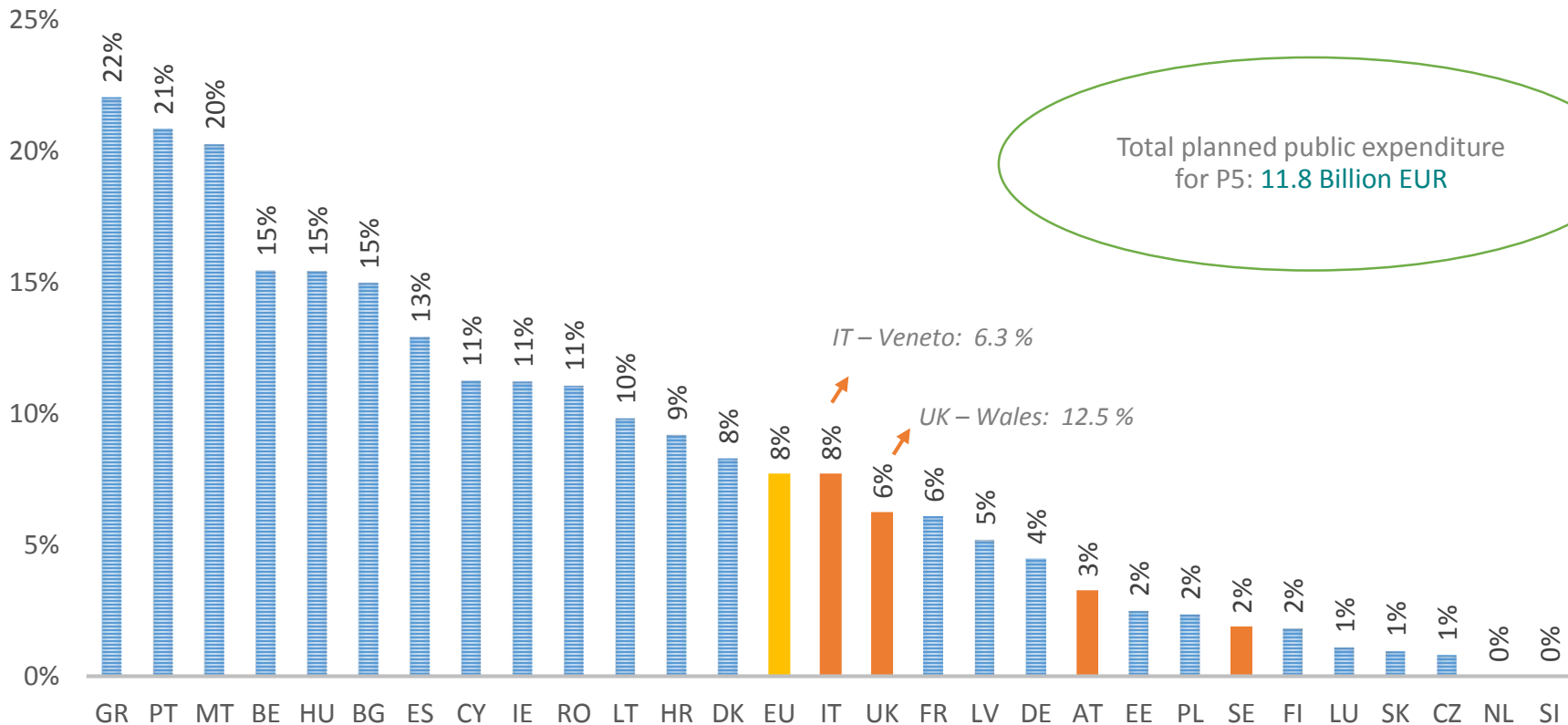

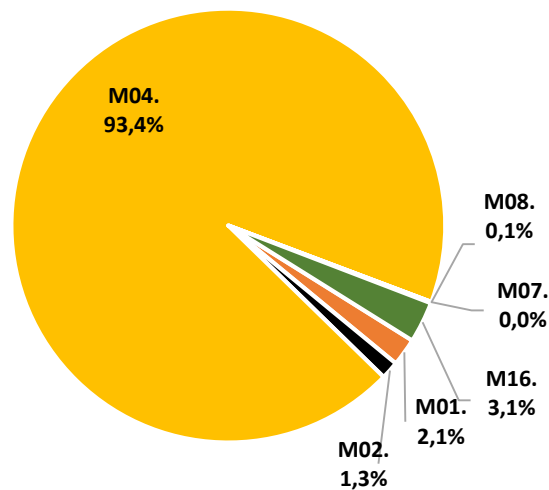

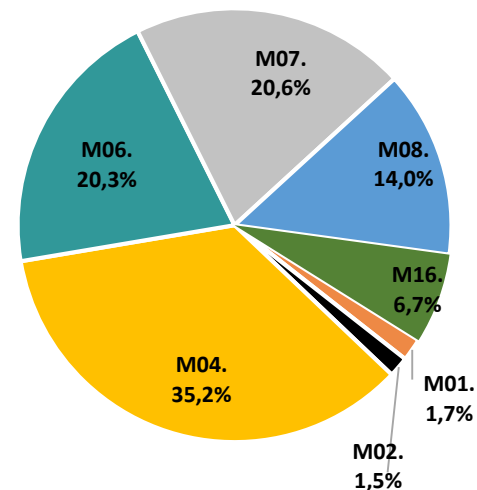

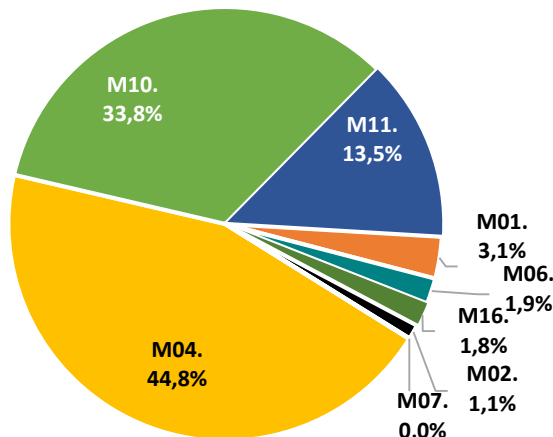

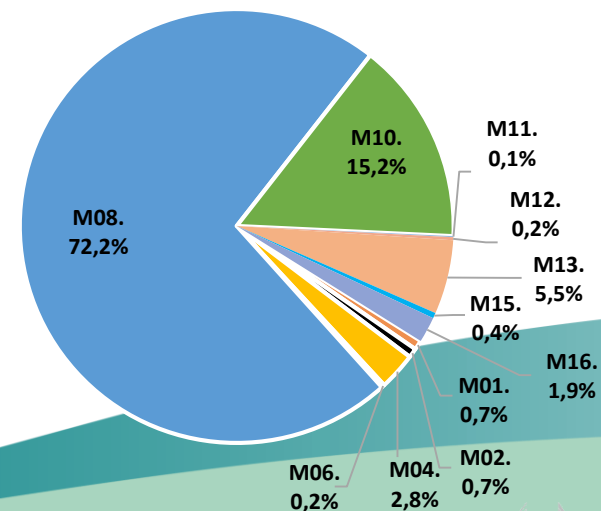
