County Donegal










- 4th Largest County in Ireland
- 13th population, aprox 160.000
- 32 persons/km2
- Main town: Letterkenny (aprox 20,000 inhabitants)
- 2nd: Buncrana (aprox. 6,700 inhabitants)
- Longest coastal line 1134 km/ 1315 km including islands
- Less than 20 km land connection to rest of ROI






