#### VILLAGE PRIMARY SCHOOL



The school has operated 123 years 23 schoolchildren, age 7-12 Two teachers, part time school assistant Two classes: 1-2 and 3-6 degrees Junior secondary school at Tammela Upper secondary school at Forssa Village Association arranges activities for schoolchildren after schooldays Other activities at school:

- \* English study group for villagers in Tuesday evenings
- \* Icehockey rink is freezed and kept fine by voluntary parents
- \* Exhibition of local handworks in July every year, organized by the village association
- \* Backyard hut, yard fence, bike shelter etc. made by voluntary villagers
- \* Tablets, instruments and means for teaching provided by the village association

# **VPK - VOLUNTARY FIRE BRIGADE OF THE VILLAGE**



Established in 1929

- \* Fire alarm group cnsists of 18 persons
- \* Fire fighting truck, water tanker and first aid crew car
- \* The fire fighting truck and the crew car were bought by donated assets in 2015 and 2018 (350 000 €)
- \* Ca. 60 alarms per year, first aid in attendance in 5-10 minutes

#### **MULTIFUNTIONAL HALL**



- \* Built in 2003-2005, voluntary work and EU/LEADER funding
- \* Two premises to hire for entrepreneurs
- \* Machine fixing hall, slaughterhouse for moose and deers, gym, weaving room, minilibrary, shower, water filling, metal and waste paper collection
- \* Machine repairing course on thursdays
- \* Weaving club on Wednesdays
- \* Gym available 24/7

# **RIVER SIDE CAFE**



VILLAGE SMITHY





Built in 1875
The village blacksmith worked here until the 1970's
Volunteer villagers renovated the smithy in 2013-2014
Now it is used as a store for various articles
It serves also as an arena for panel discussions in events
