The LEADER Thematic Lab on ‘Designing LEADER for resilience and sustainability’ will involve 30 representatives from Managing Authorities, National Rural Networks and LAGs in exploring various aspects of designing LEADER for local community resilience and sustainability. Based on practical experiences participants will have the opportunity to exchange about how various aspects of resilience (social, economic, environmental, institutional) can be integrated into designing LEADER under the future CAP Strategic Plans with the objective of enabling local action groups to deliver results for more resilient local communities. The potential role and contribution of LEADER and existing LAGs on these themes already during the transition period to the new CAP will also be considered.

Aims

- To facilitate exchange of experiences between Managing Authorities, National Rural Networks, Paying Agencies and Local Action Groups involved in designing LEADER under the CAP Strategic Plans.
- To identify the key elements and programming considerations for the successful design and implementation of LEADER interventions that enable local action groups to deliver results for local community resilience and local sustainability, under the future CSP, and during the transition period.
