FRENCH CONTEXT: a Huge change

- → Decentralization process for 2014-2020 27 RDP : regional authorities are MAs
- → Orientation quantified with performance targets& indicators
- → Involvement in national Innovative actions (EIP + collective projects)

NRN specific Program: MAIN FACTS

- ✓ Adopted by European Commission on 13th of February 2015
- ✓ 3 pilots: Ministry of Agriculture (MA), ARF (Association of French region) and CGET (special commission in charge of territories)
- ✓ More than 230 national structures are official members (signature of charter)
- ✓ Budget provides 23 Millions € on a total of 11, 4 € EAFRD global
- **✓ Essential partners : 27 Regional rural networks**



INSTALLATION OF 2014-2020 NRN



CALL FOR PROJETS – French NRN 2015

FIRST CALL FOR PROJECT LAUNCHED FOR NRN 2014-2020

- → Intensive reflex ion of more than 6 months
- → June 19th deadline then selection process with "commission" in July
- → Instruction and partnership agreements expected over for an early autumn effective start

FINALITIES OBJECTIVES: COLLECTIVE MOBILIZATION FOR RURAL DEVELOPMENT (MCDR)

- → To help emergence of cooperative projects and network of actors on national thematic chosen for NRN
- → Get a <u>successful approach of Various EAFRD-related messages</u>, strategy and projects contents (27 RDP)

STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES for MCDR

- To contribute to quality improvement of RDP
- To support raise of innovative methods and solutions by networking
- To ensure transfer of useful concrete knowledge, tools, methods and know-how
- To facilitate articulation and cooperation between national and regional scale & RD Structures
- To be force of proposal in political exchanges



CALL FOR PROJETS – French NRN 2015

HOW?

Reorientate the debates on the regional and inter-regional problematics = pertinent and coherent with RDP Bring content, points of view, enhance & foster the debates...

METHODS IMPOSE For selected projects: COLLECTIVE APPROACH

- To ensure good articulation with RDP content: measure analysis, itws, monitoring & reporting...
- To be an disinterested intermediary find balance between technical and political involvement
- To « go local » and « use relay » in region & ensure that strategy and materials reach intended audiences
- To adapt Strategic & thematic messages and materials to be relevant at the local level
- To transmit directly, positively and quickly the results
- To participate to dissemination, transfers, and capitalization event of national rural network

MODALITIES

- -Pluri-annual projects: 18 months to 36 months with an intermediate evaluation
- -Collective partnership
- -Total budget: 2 millions and a maximum of 200 000 euros per year
