


Purpose of Workshop 2

1. NRN Self-assessment framework



- Networks are tools (not end results)
- Need to be assessed against the improvement made in the rural development policy context (objectives)
- Outputs are important, but...results are even more important




2. Suggested NRN self-assessment statistics – outputs

Communication

- No of network events (by geographical level/ by main themes)
- No of people participating
- No of communication tools (helplines, webpages, etc.)
- No of people reached through tools

Collection & dissemination of good practice



Exchange of experience & know-how

- No of thematic exchange platforms
 (thematic groups, online forums.../ by
 main theme)
- No of people involved (by type)
- No of ENRD activities the NRN participated in

2. Suggested NRN self-assessment statistics – outputs

Capacity-building & training



 No of people participating in training activity (by type of stakeholder)

Cooperation support



- No of cooperation initiatives & number of people involved
- No of partner-search offers collected/disseminated
- No of inquires responded
