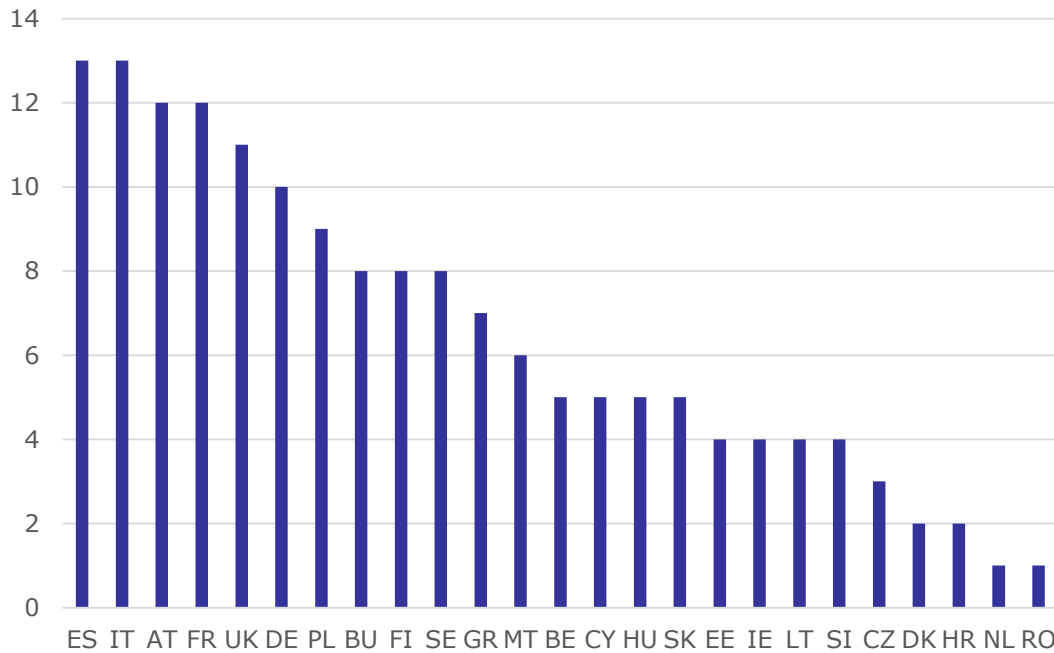

- *Fills a gap between LEADER and PG/Quality*

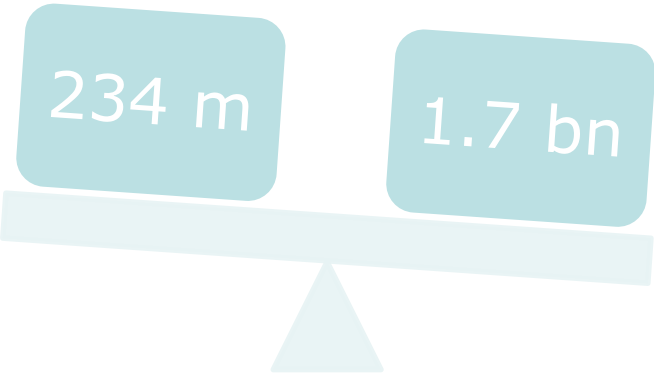

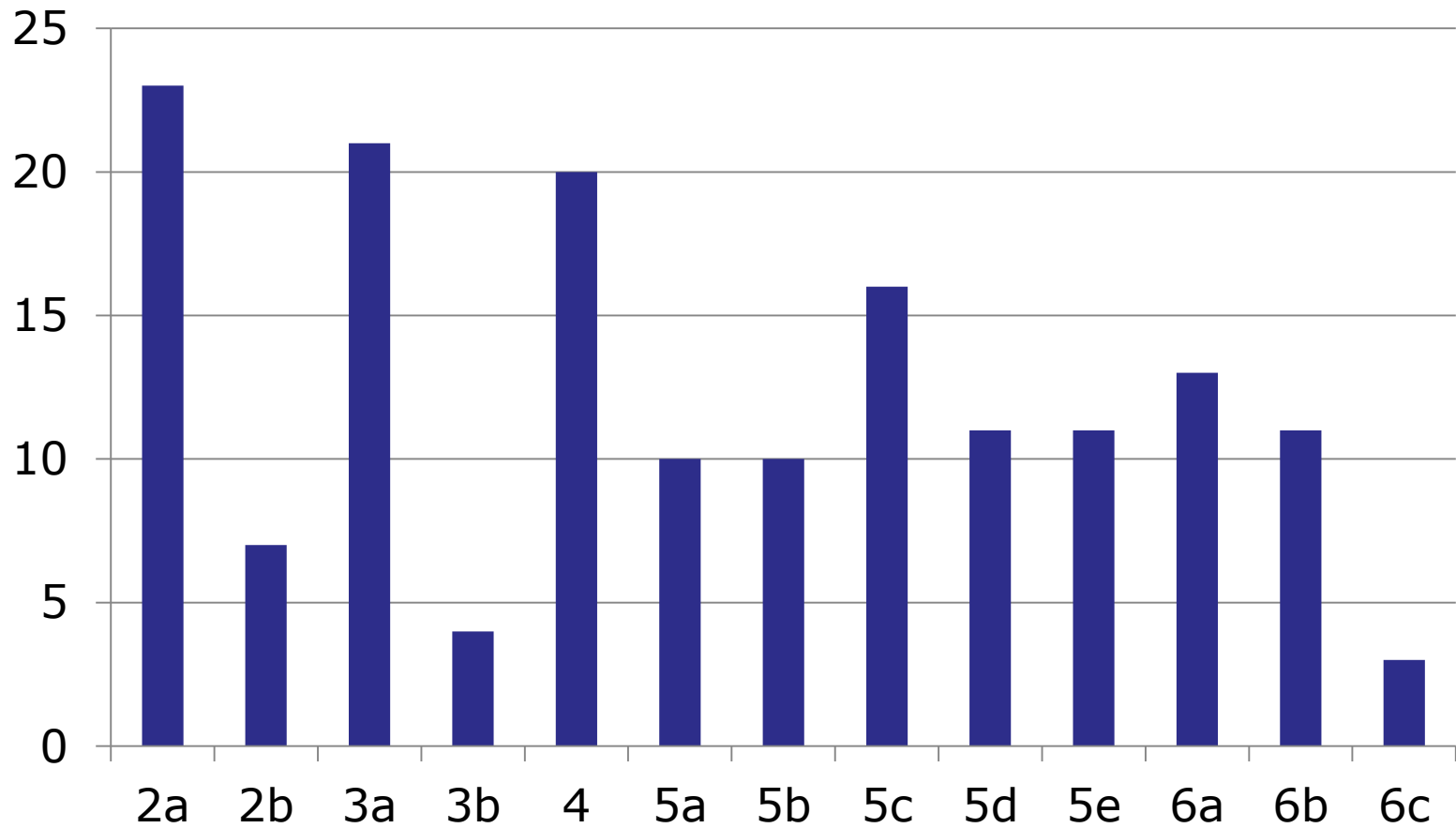

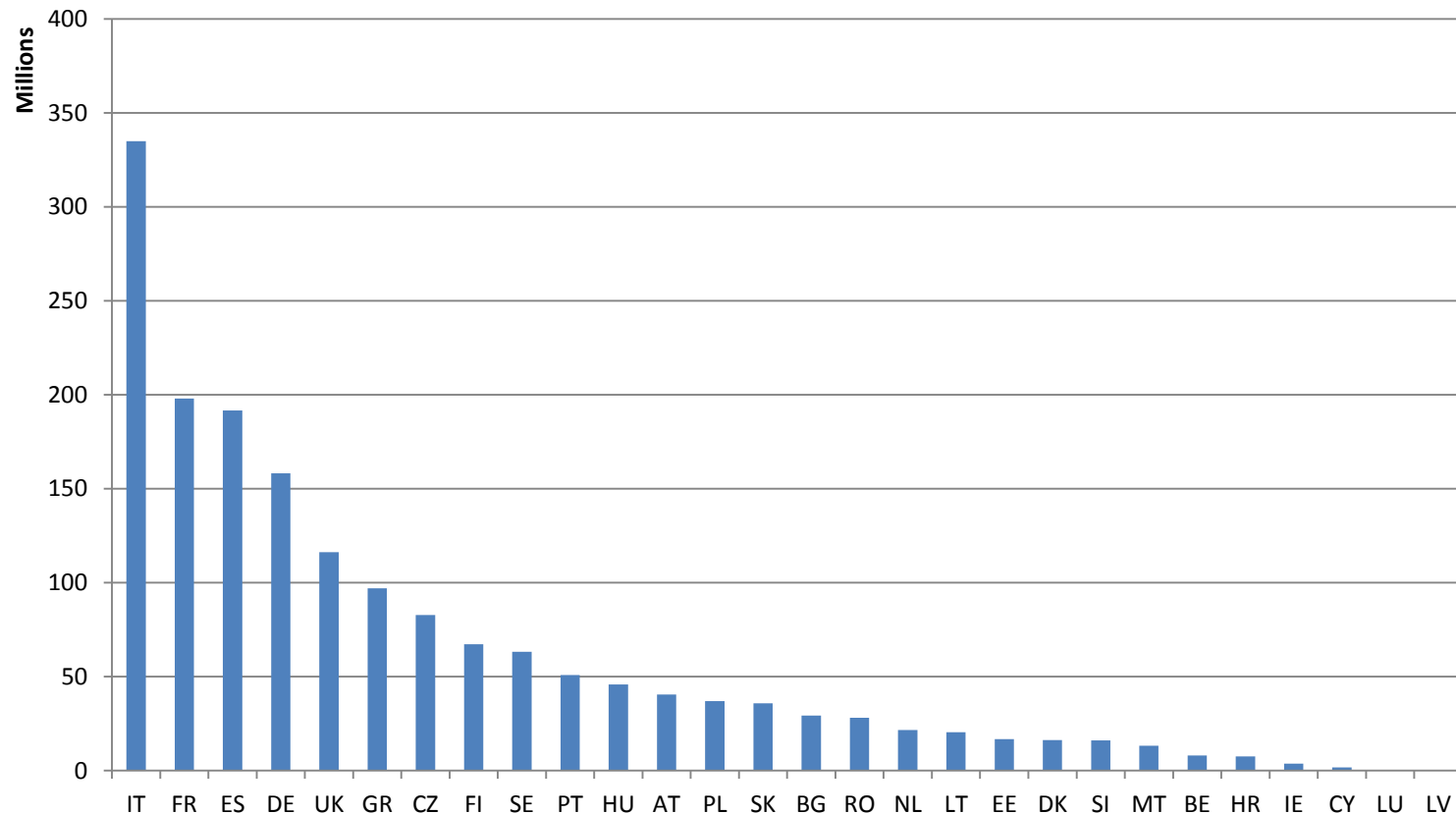

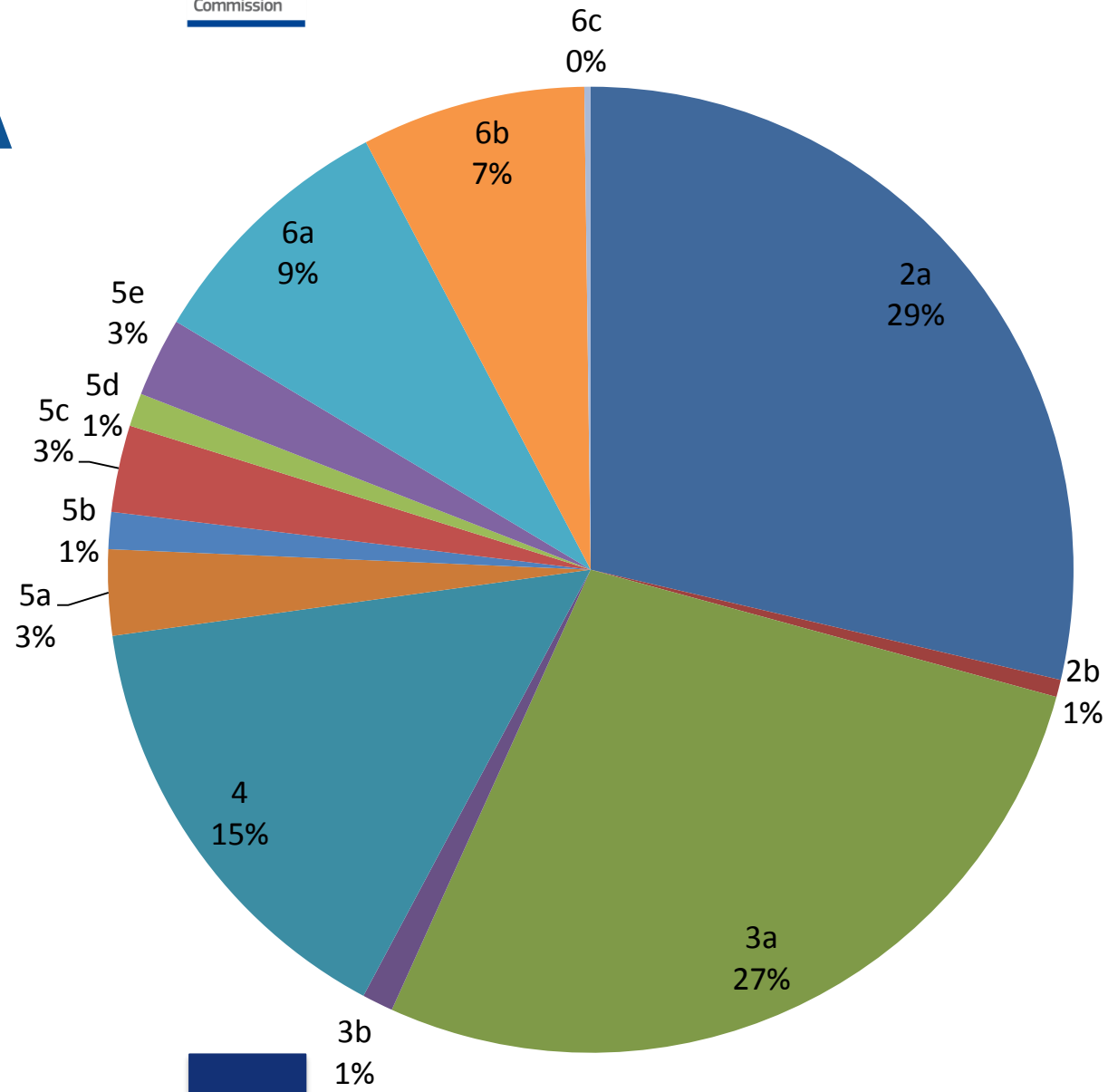
M16 PER FOCUS AREA

- ❖ 1 ENTITY/5 \neq COOPERATION
- ❖ DEVELOPMENT

- MAX SUPPORT RATE IS SET OUT IN ANNEX 2:
40/50/75 + BONUS

How to apply the principle to projects with a limited time scope and/or experimental projects?

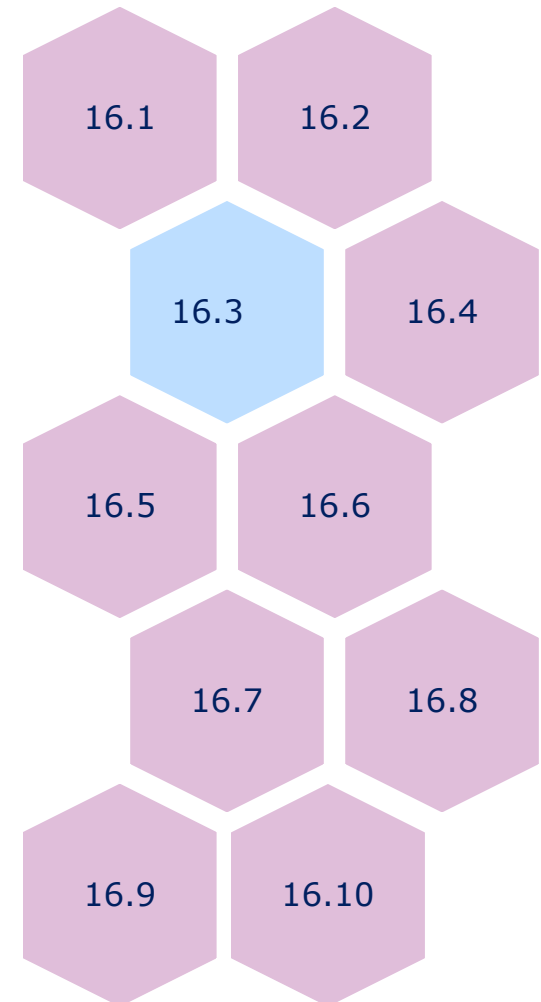
Main solution lies with the definition of "productive investment"; criteria to be set by MS

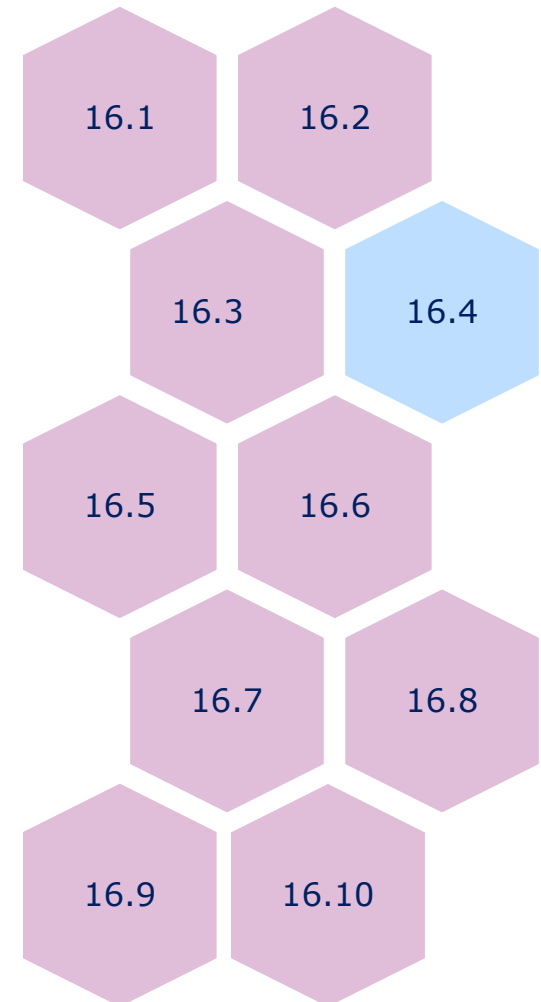

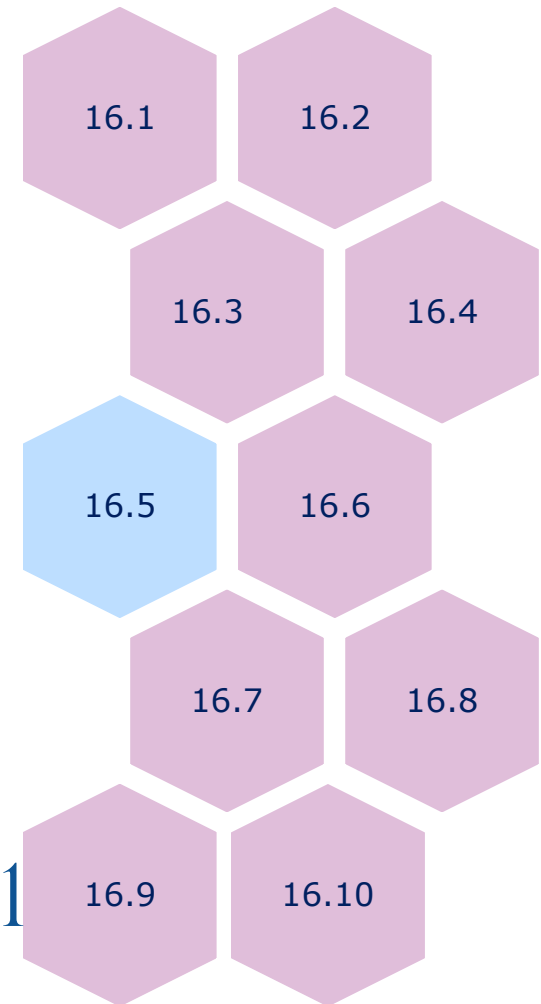

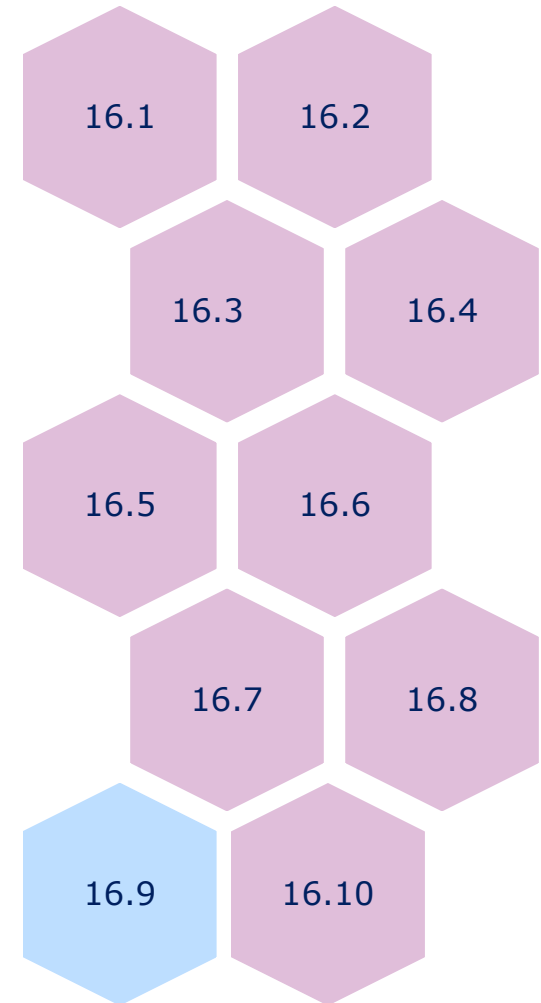

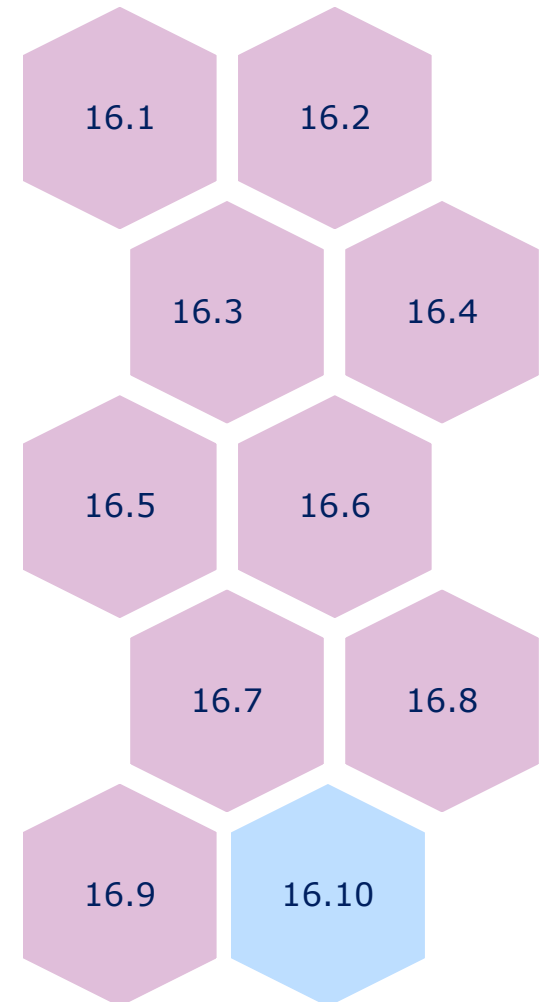
