administration process

- processing on the basis of IACS in an oracledatabase
- only online applications
- area-aids with graphically application and full digitalisation of farmland
- output of the premium calculation is laid down in graphical format



LPIS layers

- application data
 - field parcels
 - <u>cultures</u>, <u>AECM-codes</u>, <u>wintergreening</u>
- ecological focus areas
- Natura 2000
- environmentally sensitive grassland
- national parks
- conservation areas (ground water, others)



data synchronisation

- data synchronisation must be performed automatically
- set LPIS-layers upon each other to gain overlaps (in particularly for premium calculation)
- for each layer is laid down:
 - concerning agri-environmental measure
 - validity period



exclusion of granting subsidies for the relevant measure



problems/challenges

- no reduction of premiums possible only full premium or not
- huge number of possible premium overlaps, e.g. aids/regulations from EU, national, provinces, municipalities
- graphic format often not available, borders not exact
- on the spot-check de facto not possible
- non-satisfying solution: applicant gives a code in the claim
