And the cost of living is also much higher. But the income from the our farm is the same as 1990!


So we have a problem here!





Figur B. Kostnader (SEK/m³f ub) för gallring (löpande priser)


Figure B. Costs (SEK/m³f ub) for thinning in current prices




The urbanization of Sweden 1800-2018



INTERNATIONAL TOURIST ARRIVALS 1950 - 2030




