- Villages or groups of villages can apply, municipalities not allowed
- Registration
 - Identified challenges -> Improve or maintain
 - Who are the partners
 - What are the planned activities
 - What type of outside help is needed
- The competition ends at the end of 2019
- The village that develops itself the most, wins.


