






The traditional face of policy making in rural Scotland....not very socially inclusive!











SAYFC- The home of rural youth in Scotland since 1938





SAYFC Agri and Rural Affairs: re-launched June 2013. Chairman, full time staff member, and a vision.






SAYFC Agri and Rural Affairs aims to:


