

#### **Essentials**



- LEADER/CLLD principles are essential
- There is no one model...
- Social innovation, technology, communities
- LEADER is one of the instruments (but not the only one!) for supporting smart village initiatives
- LEADER can support preparatory work, animation, strategies, projects



## **Smart Villages and LEADER**

- "LEADER already includes all the elements needed to implement the smart villages concept"
- "More LEADER for more smart villages" animation, facilitation, innovation, faster and more flexible funding, broad scope of interventions and adequate resources
- Smart villages are "rural communities that refuse to wait for change to happen to them"
- **Broad range** of current initiatives: digital transition, broadband infrastructure, local food ecosystem, bioenergy villages, and others
- "Digital technologies are not a precondition for becoming a smart village"
- Build on existing strengths, traditional and modern networks, innovation
