## Contribution of OPHC to the EU Strategy

- adopted on 25<sup>th</sup> of February 2015
- UE 4,326 bilion euro (105,9 billion YEI + 4,220 billion Euro FSE)
- role in:
  - OT 8 supporting labor capacity and mobility, specially among young people and unemployed persons
  - OT 9 promoting social inclusion and combating poverty
  - OT 10 supporting education, competencies development and encouraging lifetime educational process

## Differences between 2007-2013 and 2014-2020

- Special allocations from "Jobs for young people" initiative (YEI): sustainable integration on the labor market for young people, for 3 eligible regions (where unemployment is bigger than 25% Centru, Sud-Est şi Sud Muntenia);
- Measures oriented towards self employment and encouraging entrepreneurship, using also financial instruments;
- Dedicated measures to disadvantaged communities, particularly Roma communities;
- Focus on integrated projects that respond to community's needs (areas of interest: education, labor, social services and health, living, volunteering);
- > Plans that aim to encourage social, also through financial instruments;
- Use of global grants schemes in implementing the interventions (spcially for entrepreneurships cases)
- Use of the CLLD instrument
