The Advisory Service provides a range of subsidised, independent, confidential and bespoke advice to:

The aim of the service is to ensure that businesses:

- •benefit from business support and/or technical advice, tailored to their business needs
- •reduce costs by increasing efficiency across all areas of the business
- benchmark their performance and work towards progress and growth
- •identify areas for improvement and find solutions to problems



Limitations:

FARMING connect cyswllt FFERMIO

The Advisory Service is available on a 1-to-1 basis.

The 'individual' advice element is up to 80% funded to a maximum of €1500 (euros) per instance of advice for registered businesses.

It is also available to 'groups' of individuals wanting to collaborate and address the same or similar topics.

The 'group' advice element is 100% funded up to a maximum of €1,500 (euros) per group member.


4 instances of advice is available to every eligible business.
