- Energy efficiency at home and in the office

Here you find tips on how to save energy or how to make your energy consumption more sustainable by using renewable energy. The tips are rather basic, very operational and easy to implement. Thus, the 50 top tips can be used as a check list on how we live our lives from an energy point of view.

The last three tips in the leaflet give advice on how you can act in order to persuade others to change habits through the media, political representatives and through online action.
