I wish that more attention and more investments could be dedicated to the sub-programme for 'Environment', priority area "nature and biodiversity". In particular, the monitoring of the status of the invertebrate species of the Habitat Directive (and more in general of the IUCN red lists) regarding the climate change which is going on. Invertebrates (and Insects in particular) are essential for the ecological web and to verify the status of the endangered species is very important in order to put in place the necessary actions to protect/increase the populations which could be in danger due to the climate change.
