## **Feedback:**

*We express our appreciation to Commission to open an evaluation process in order to update Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 on shipments of waste (Waste Shipment Regulation - WSR).*

*As well, we expect this evaluation could asses WSR objectives and it is coherent with the general objectives of EU environmental policy, circular economy and the internal market.*

*We would like to point out that article 16 Principles of self-sufficiency and proximity of Directive 2008/98/EC should be included in WSR with a view to simplified and systematizing legislation, specially, to fulfill coherence and consistency objectives.*

*By the way, according to article 30 of WSR, to reduce unnecessary administrative burden, member States could conclude bilateral agreements making the notification procedure for shipments of specific flows of waste less stringent in respect of cross-border shipments to the nearest suitable facility located in the border area whenever a specific geographical or demographical situation warrants such a step. Therefore, we would like to study if extending this privilege to other non-OCDE countries, which are set deep in a Member State and they are not self – sufficiency, allows to ensure a high level of protection of environment and human health. So, we think this is a big opportunity to face all these challenges.*

*Finally, we wonder if this evaluation process will affect to financial guarantee, since one of evaluation objectives is to investigate costs and benefits associated with the implementation of the WSR for the stakeholders.*
