The European Recycling Industries' Confederation (EuRIC) strongly welcomes the publication of the Roadmap to evaluate the Waste Shipment Regulation (EC) No 1013/2006 (WSR). The WSR is causing substantial administrative burdens for recycling companies, many of them SMEs, resulting among other things in delays and additional cost for shipment of raw materials from recycling. As a reaction to this roadmap, representing one step ultimately leading to a review of the WSR, EuRIC calls on the European Commission to seize this opportunity for easing and streamlining waste shipments procedures. Doing so is an instrumental step forward to turn current obstacles into necessary solutions for the well-functioning of secondary raw materials markets and guarantee that in a circular economy raw materials from recycling can "circulate".
