## Feedback:

- 1. Burning waste is not renewable energy generation. I think "waste" in this context is a product of commercialism and is not to be compared with sun or wind as a source for energy.*
- 2. Incineration is a very dubious "business" area as it relies on "waste"fullness for its raw materials. It is not something that should be made attractive to businesses and should eventually be eliminated.*
- 3. Waste that is not recyclable (and then needs to be dealt with causing further cost/pollution, i.e. transport) should be eliminated by phasing out the generation / production of non-recyclable waste.*
- 4. Burning waste is not a clean and efficient method of energy generation. It produces more CO2 per mWh than fossil fuels. It is not in the same category as real renewable energy generation.*
