### **Feedback:**

*Waste should not be a commodity that can be traded with.*

*Already, there is a lack of balance between number, capacity and location of incinerators, and the waste they burn. This means that waste handling has moved from being focused on reducing and recycling waste, to actually paradoxically encouraging more waste.*

*The roadmap lacks taking into consideration health, social and environmental issues related to burning waste for energy.*

*Modern societies, if they cannot minimise and avoid waste, should at least be expected to have smart waste treatment strategies, such as recycling, reusing, and since it will meet so little of the energy demand it is not worth it.*
