## Feedback:

*I'm very concerned that the roadmap classifies waste incineration as renewable energy. I suspect this is more to do with meeting renewables targets than with genuine environmental principles of reducing emissions.*

*We should be aiming to reduce waste, not regard it as a source of energy.*

*Burning waste produces more CO<sub>2</sub> per megawatt of energy produced than does any fossil fuel consumption - it makes no sense at all in terms of carbon emissions.*

*Even if it these factors are disregarded, it is not a logical investment to build incineration plants now, when the agreed plan is to REDUCE incineration to only one third of Europe's waste over the next 15 years; we'll end up with over-capacity, for a method that is recognised as environmentally negative.*

*Please look at better, longer term, more genuinely green alternatives.*
