Feedback:

CEMBUREAU welcomes the upcoming Commission Communication on Waste to Energy and is confident that it will contain a good balance of the contribution of energy recovery both from dedicated WtE incinerators and from co-incineration plants, e.g. co-processing in cement plants. CEMBUREAU also expects that, as per the roadmap, the Communication on WtE will rightly highlight the potential that can be boosted across the EU for waste-derived fuels to further contribute to the energy security of supply, one of the objectives of the Energy Union Strategy. The EU cement industry, which uses alternative fuels for 41% of its fuel mix, strongly supports measures to phase out landfilling of recyclable and recoverable waste, so that – specifically from non-recyclable waste – energy and material can be efficiently recovered and thereby contribute to resource circularity. Co-processing combines in the cement kiln the cement manufacturing process with the treatment of the waste that replaces fossil fuels and/or natural mineral resources, thereby combining energy recovery and material recycling.
