Pilot closed	On 7 April 2014 the European Commission decided to stop the OEFSR pilot on household sanitary goods and toiletries as it became progressively evident that the pilot was not sufficiently backed by the major producers and the relevant European associations. Considering that the Commission position about this exercise has always been not to impose anything to industry but rather to help addressing needs on their side, the pilot is stopped.
