The national standard form (which is obligatory below the EU thresholds) of the contact award notice includes data fields where contracting authorities can indicate if the procurement has included social and or environmental clauses as contractual clause/ award criteria/ as part of the technical specifications/ as environmental measures within the framework of the selection criteria / as a compliance with environmental management schemes within the framework of the selection criteria. However as EU standard forms do not include such data fields these statistics contain only green procedures launched above national threshold and below EU threshold. In 2015 contracting authorities below the EU threshold used environmental aspects in 9% of their procedures, expressed at valorem 18%.

As regards the GPP monitoring, the Public procurement Office developed in 2016, a new monitoring method which is based on analysis of information delivered by contracting authorities in annual report on awarded contracts. The annual reports on awarded contracts are submitted by all the contracting authorities by means of an online form placed at the Public Procurement Office portal. A new standard form of annual report on awarded contracts, which each and individual contracting authority is obliged to submit to the Public Procurement Office, was adopted in Dec., 2016 by means of a regulation (a secondary legislation to the Public Procurement Law). A special table was added in order to identify all the possibilities of inclusion of environmental aspects as provided for in the 2016 amended Public Procurement Law (all these aspects are stipulated in the 2014 EU PP Directives). The Public Procurement Office of Poland shall then possess detailed information on all awarded contracts where some environmental considerations were found (in case of contracts awarded in 2016 – the information is narrowed to contracts awarded under 2016 amended Public Procurement Law).

The 2018 Decree on GPP states that monitoring of green public procurement should be performed:

- (1) On the basis of information on public procurement awarded in the previous year, the Ministry responsible for public procurement shall, by 30 September of the current year at the latest, prepare a statistical report on the award of green public procurement and include it in the statistical report referred to in the third paragraph of Article 107 of the ZJN- 3.
- (2) The statistical report on the awarded green public procurement referred to in the preceding paragraph shall contain at least the following information:
- the number and value of green procurement awarded and the proportion of green procurement awarded in relation to the number and value of all public contracts awarded;
- the number and value of the awarded green public procurement and the proportion of green procurement awarded in relation to the number and value of all awarded public contracts, separately broken down into the field of public procurement, the type of public procurement object, the code of the single public procurement vocabulary (CPV), the items referred to in paragraph Article 4 of this Regulation and public procurement procedures;
- the frequency of the methods used to integrate the environmental aspects referred to in the second paragraph of Article 7 of this Decree in the award of green public procurement;
- the number and proportion of subscribers who have awarded at least one green public contract broken down to the subscriber category and the number of subscribers who have awarded at least one public contract but did not award any green public procurement broken down by the subscriber category and the proportion of these subscribers the number of subscribers of the same category who, at that time, awarded at least one public contract;
- the number and value of the awarded green public procurement and the proportion of green public contracts awarded, according to the number and value of all awarded public contracts, broken down by type of procurement subject and providers established in the Republic of Slovenia, another Member State of the European Union and a third country;
- the number of providers established in the Republic of Slovenia, the other EU Member State and the third country to which at least one green public procurement has been awarded, broken down by type of public procurement subject, and the proportion of those tenderers by number of successful tenderers with the same type of object public procurement;
- the number of bidders to whom at least one green public contract has been awarded, broken down by the type of object of the contract and the size of the tenderer, and the proportion of those tenderers according to the number of selected tenderers for the public contract with the same type of object of the contract.

Results of last monitoring (for 2018):

In 2018, public procurer placed 16,865 tenders worth EUR 2,918,594,609. At least one environmental aspect was included in 5771 contracts, representing 34.22% of all contracts awarded this year. The value of these orders is 559,393,716 euros, which represents a 19.17% share.

Results from the latest monitoring exercise		Monitoring of GPP will be an important part of the upcoming national action plan and is planned to be done within prioritised sectors such as transport, construction and buildings, food and meal services, and ICT equipment. Monitoring is planned to be done on four pillars: 1) monitoring of the preconditions for green/sustainable procurements, 2) monitoring of practices, 3) monitoring of environmental and cost effects and 4) monitoring of benefits to society.  The first pillar (preconditions) will mainly focus on enterprises' competence, leader focus, goals, budgets, tools, barriers, etc., and will be done using surveys. Digdir sent out a large survey in 2018 which revealed lacking competence among public enterprises. We are currently planning a follow-up survey to be released in 2020.  The second pillar (practices) will focus on how procurers work in order to achieve GPP. Monitoring will be done using surveys (e.g. on planning of procurements), online forms where procurers respond if they have used environmental criteria, and automated analysis of tenders to see if they include environmental criteria (e.g. Digdirs criteria) and hopefully an estimate on the level of ambition.  The third pillar (effects) will focus on environmental effects (such as emissions) and is planned to be measured using pilot procurements which use Digdirs criteria, and theoretical estimated of effects using the literature. We will develop online calculators which will estimate effects based on what we learn which can be used by procurers to estimate their own effect on purchases. We have currently made two calculators showing the effects on emissions and costs using Digdirs criteria for procurements of cars and vans.  The fourth pillar (benefits to society) will focus on how GPP is helping support national climate and environmental goals. This may investigate the effects GPP has on emissions and costs, and put this into the context of national goals, policy and ambitions.
