Purpose & framework Green Public Procurement (GPP) is an important tool to achieve environmental policy goals relating to climate change, resource use and sustainable consumption and production – especially given the [importance of public sector spending](#) on goods and services in Europe.

This is the second of the two webinars of 2021, as part of the European Commission's [Helpdesk service on GPP](#). The webinar will focus on the revised voluntary [EU GPP criteria for computers, monitors, tablets and smartphones](#), which have been designed to encompass the most important environmental impacts during the life cycle of these products (product lifetime extension, energy consumption, hazardous substances, end-of-life management) and which include also criteria that apply to separate procurements for refurbished/remanufactured devices and related services.
