Article 14(1) ESF Regulation

What is it?

- An empowerment to allow the Commission adopt Simplified Cost Options using a Delegated Act
- Can apply to any Member State for any types of operations

Why use it?

- Legal Certainty
- Accounting practices
- Can cover more types of operations





Article 14(1) ESF Regulation

- Unit costs and lump sums included in the DA could be
 - Proposed by an individual Member State based on its own data
 - Proposed by the Commission for a group or all Member States, based on for example Eurostat data.
- Strong political commitment by Commission to support Member States wishing to use SCOs
- Goal of 50% of ESF covered by SCO during 2014-2020 period





The Delegated Regulation

Articles 1 to 4 cover:

- Subject matter and scope
- Types of operations
- Definitions of standard scales of unit costs and lump sums and their amounts
- Adjustment of amounts

Annex:

- One for each Member State
- Indicator definition, measurement unit and amount
- Adjustment of amounts






Social Affairs and Inclusion

Adding an annex for **Portugal**





France:

- Unit costs for OP La Réunion
 - Individual professional training
 - Vocational health training
 - Result-based
- Lump sum for Technical Assistance (OP ESF and OP YEI)

Czechia:

8 new unit costs





Malta:

- Changes to 4 existing unit costs
- 1 new unit cost for scholarships based on ECTS achieved (result-based)

Italy:

- Inclusion of PON Lombardia and PON Inclusione into several existing UC
- Extension of scope for UC "Mobility programmes for researchers" –3 OPs added





Italy:

- New unit costs for NOP YEI and NOP SAEP
 - Group training
 - Individual training
 - General training
 - Civil service operations

Slovakia:

 Amendments to 5 existing unit costs (drafting changes and amounts)





The Netherlands:

 New unit cost for provision of additional labour market guidance to VET students

Romania:

 New unit costs for provision of meals to children attending crèches

EU-level SCOs:

 Updating amounts with latest ESTAT figures for <u>education</u>





Cyprus:

• New unit costs for the modernisation of the public administration of OP Employment, Human Resources and Social Cohesion

Ireland:

- Lump sum for Technical Assistance
- New unit cost for staff working in the Social Inclusion and Community Activation Programme (SICAP)





Portugal:

• New annex with unit costs for non-formal training of public sectors employees.
