of the European Union Delegation to Afghanistan for Grants

1. Basic act and/or Financing source

Financing agreement number: DCI-ASIE/2010/21730; Action Fiche N° 2

Budget line: 19.10 01 02, Healthcare Delivery

2. Objectives of the programme, priorities for 2013 and expected results

To improve the health status of the Afghan population with more focus on disabled vulnerable group.
Expected results are:

1. Establishment of Technical Orthopedic Technician Training Department in the structure of MoPH Educational Institution.
2. To support the provision of BPHS/EPHS defined disability and rehabilitation health services through increased numbers of professionally trained rehabilitation practitioners.
3. Increase the access to specialized physical rehabilitation services for persons with disabilities through increasing the numbers of Orthopedic Centres.

The Implementation duration of the programme will be maximum two years.

3. Eligibility conditions

Eligible organisations (i.e. applicant and co-applicant(s)) under this call shall :

- be legal persons **and**
- be non-profit-making **and**
- be established in Afghanistan **or** in a Member State of the European Union **and**
- be directly responsible for the preparation and management of the action with the co-applicant(s) and affiliated entity(ies), not acting as an intermediary **and**
- be nationals of a Member State of the European Union **or** of Afghanistan **or** other eligible countries as per the relevant provisions of DCI regulations (1341/2011 modifying 1905/2006) **and**
- be national or international non-governmental organisations officially registered with the Ministry of the Economy of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan **and**
- have a Memorandum of Understanding with the MoPH **or** will do the necessary to have one.

4. Selection and award criteria

The evaluation will be carried out in accordance with the procedures set out in the Practical Guide to contract procedures for EU external actions.

5. Maximum rate of European Union financing

100%

6. Indicative time-schedule of calls for proposals

The call for proposals is planned to be published in May 2013 with a provisional deadline for submission of concept notes in June 2013 and tentative submission deadline for the full application form in August 2013 (Restricted Call for Proposals).

7. Indicative amount of calls for proposals

280,000.00 Euro
