1. Basic act and Financing source

Support to the health and nutrition sector of Afghanistan DCI-ASIE2010 / 021-730

2. Objectives of the programme, priorities for 2011 and expected results

Implementation of the Basic Package of Health Services (BPHS) and Essential Package of Hospital Services (EPHS) in 10 EU supported province, Afghanistan

3. Eligibility conditions

(1) In order to be eligible for a grant, applicants **must**:

- be legal persons **and**
- be non profit making **and**
- be national or international non -governmental organizations officially registered with the Ministry of the Economy of the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan **and**
- Be nationals¹ of a Member State of the European Union or of Afghanistan or other eligible countries as per the relevant provisions of DCI regulations²
- Be directly responsible for the preparation and management of the action with their partners, not acting as an intermediary **and**
- Have a Memorandum of Understanding with the MoPH .

(2) Potential applicants may not participate in calls for proposals or be awarded grants if they are in any of the situations which are listed in Section 2.3.3 of the Practical Guide to contract procedures for EC external actions (available from the following Internet address:

http://ec.europa.eu/europeaid/work/procedures/implementation/index_en.htm);

4. Selection and award criteria

The evaluation will be carried out in accordance with the procedures set out in the Practical Guide to

¹ Such nationality being determined on the basis of the organisation's statutes which should demonstrate that it has been established by an instrument governed by the internal law of the country concerned. In this respect, any legal entity whose statutes have been established in another country cannot be considered an eligible local organisation, even if they are registered locally or accompanied by a "Memorandum of Understanding".
