#### **1. Basic act and/or Financing source**

1. EIDHR 2012 AAP - CBSS (Country Based Support Schemes) (Local Call for Proposals)
2. THE ENERGY SUPPORT: Energy and Energy Efficiency Programme in Jordan (Decision 2011/22-721) (Local Call for Proposals).
3. Non-state actors (NSA) – Local Authorities 2013: Actions in partner countries, NSA Budget Line 21 03 01, LA: Budget Line 21 03 02, (Local Call for Proposals)

#### **2. Objectives of the programme, priorities and expected results**

1. EIDHR/CBSS: Strengthening the role of Jordanian civil society in promoting human rights and democratic reform, priorities not yet approved.
2. ENERGY SUPPORT: The general objective of this Sector Policy Support Programme is to contribute to the development and implementation of effective policies and tools that will help Jordan to reach the renewable energy and energy efficiency goals set by the Government for 2020, three groups of results are expected at the end of the Programme:
  - Reform and capacity building of Government institutions
  - Renewable energy and energy efficiency in existing and new buildings
  - Complementary support to RE development

As for the relevant call for proposals, it will focus on Renewable energy and energy efficiency demonstration projects in buildings

#### **3. NON-STATE ACTORS AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES IN DEVELOPMENT:**

##### **Non-state actors (NSA)**

The overarching objective shall be the strengthening of civil society in partner countries as a pre-condition for a more equitable, open and democratic society. These interventions shall encompass small-scale local development activities in a wide range of sectors and themes such as water and sanitation, health, education, employment, migration, etc.

##### **Local Authorities (LA)**

The overarching objective shall be the enhancement of the participation of LA and ALA in partner countries in public policies and programmes as a pre-condition for a more equitable, open and democratic society. These actions shall encompass local development activities in a wide range of sectors and themes where LA have an institutional mandate and competencies, and in which Local Authorities intervention has a real added value such as water and sanitation, health, education, employment, migration, etc.

### **3. Eligibility conditions**

1. Jordanian NGOs and International Organisations
2. Jordanian NGOs and International Organisations
3. International and Local None State Actors

### **4. Selection and award criteria**

The evaluation will be carried out in accordance with the procedures set out in the Practical Guide to contract procedures for EU external actions.

### **5. Maximum rate of European Union financing**

1. EIDHR: Maximum 90%
2. ENERGY: 100%
3. NSA/LA: the maximum possible rate of EU co-financing of the total costs of the action is:
  - European NSA/LA maximum of 75% of the total eligible costs.
  - Partner countries NSA/LA maximum of 90% of the total eligible costs.

Full financing may only be applied in the cases provided for in Article 253 of the Implementing Rules of the Financial Regulations.
