

WORK PROGRAMME FOR GRANTS
DELEGATION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION TO LEBANON
"Youth Engagement in Implementation of the National Youth Policy"

1. Basic act and/or Financing source

Regulation (EC) No 1638/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 October 2006 laying down general provisions establishing a European Neighbourhood and Partnership Instrument (ENPI).

2. Objectives of the programme, priorities for 2013 and expected results

The **global objective** of this Call for Proposals is to contribution to the adoption and implementation of the national youth priorities and concerns namely in issues related to migration, labour, education and culture, health, social integration and youth participation in political life.

The **specific objectives** of this Call for Proposals are the following:

Enhancing youth participation in economic, social, civic, and political participation in Lebanon.

3. Eligibility conditions

(1) In order to be eligible for a grant, applicants **must**:

- be legal persons **and**
- be non profit making **and**
- be established in a Member State of the European Union, a country that it is beneficiary of the ENPI Regulation –Regulation (EC) No 1638/2006 of 24 October 2006-, a country that is a beneficiary of an Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance set up by Council Regulation (EC) No 1085/2006 of 17 July 2006 establishing an Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA) or a Member State of the European Economic Area **and**
- be directly responsible for the preparation and management of the action with their partners, not acting as an intermediary **and**
- A non -governmental organization or a network of non-governmental registered at, or having submitted its request to, the Ministry of Interior and Municipalities or at the Ministry of Youth and Sports.
- A civil institution registered at the civil company registrar (court of first Instance) as non-profit institution.

4. Selection and award criteria

The evaluation will be carried out in accordance with the procedures set out in the Practical Guide to contract procedures for EU external actions.

5. Maximum rate of European Union financing

80% of the eligible costs of the action.

6. Indicative time-schedule of calls for proposals

The launch is foreseen for the second semester 2013 (indicatively July 2013).

7. Indicative amount of calls for proposals

EUR 500,000
