1. Basic act and/or Financing source

2. Objectives of the programme, priorities for 2014-2015 and expected results

The main objective of this call for proposals is to support civil society in Georgia in working on human rights (civil, economic, health, labour and cultural) and democratisation, fight against domestic violence and discrimination on any ground so as to:

- i) pursue common agendas for human rights and democratic reform
- ii) enhance the inclusiveness and pluralism of civil society
- iii) support activities aimed at promoting the issues covered by EU Human Rights guidelines and in the EUs Strategic Framework and Action Plan on Human Rights and Democracy

3. Eligibility conditions

Legal non-for-profit- making non-governmental organisations established in Georgia or the European Union Member States. Additional requirements for eligibility will be specified in the Guidelines for Applicant for the specific Call for Proposals

4. Selection and award criteria

The evaluation will be carried out in accordance with the procedures set out in the Practical Guide.

5. Maximum rate of European Union financing

Maximum rate of European Union Financing is 95% of total eligible costs of the action.

Minimum rate European Union Financing is 50 % of total eligible costs of action

6. Indicative time-schedule of calls for proposals

The Call for Proposals is supposed to be launched no later than April 2015

7. Indicative amount of calls for proposals

EUR 1 600 000 (pooled funds from AAP 2014 and AAP 2015)
