



CROSS ISSUES IN THE AGREEMENT



Territorial Approach: **Prioritized areas** were defined for **the Implementation on Territories** most affected by the conflict and the State's neglect.

- **Integral Rural Reform:** Development Programs with a Territorial Approach - PDET.
- **Political Participation:** Temporary Territorial Districts for Peace.
- **Solving the Drug Trafficking Problem:** Integral Community-based and Municipal Plans for Substitution and Alternative Development – PISDA.
- **Victims:** Collective Reparation of Territories and Settlements most affected by the Conflict.

The core of the Peace Agreement is **the Reparation of Victims of the conflict**. On June 2014, the Negotiation Board presented the "Statement of Principles" which establishes the commitment on **the Victims' Rights to Truth, Justice, Reparation and Non Repetition**.



Direct Participation of civil society in the **construction, implementation and monitoring** of policies, plans, programs and institutions created due to the Peace Agreement.

Creation of a New Institutional Structure or modification of the existing structure, in relation to Integral Rural Reform, Political Participation, Solution to the Drug Trafficking Problem, End of the Conflict and Victims.

The coordinated **Implementation of the Agreement** establishes **Non Repetition Guarantees**, particularly the measures and mechanisms for Item 5 about Victims and Item 3 about the End of the Conflict.
