

Key facts: TLN-mobility network

TLN-mobility is a network of ESF managing authorities and political administrations from 15 member states and regions in Europe, established in 2013, initiated by the EU Commission. To date, nine member states and regions are active members.

TLN-mobility was established based on the success of the German mobility program called "IdA", which runs since 2008. The network's aim is to promote the concept of mobility programs for NEETs and to support other member states and regions who wish to implement their own programs.

TLN-mobility has developed a [coordinated call](#) to establish a coordinated framework for NEET mobility programs. The call and the corresponding [manual of guidance](#) introduce minimum requirements for the programs, but also offer flexibility, to adapt the programs to the needs of the member states' labour markets.

So far, the Basque Country, Catalonia, the Czech Republic, Galicia, Germany, Poland, Slovenia, Sweden and Trento have set up ESF-funded mobility programs based on the coordinated call.

Since 2016, TLN-mobility has promoted a proposal to launch an EU-wide NEET mobility program for the upcoming ESF funding period 2021-2027.

TLN-mobility is open for any member state or region who is interested in ALMA. The network has regular meetings which are open to join.
